I am a passionate supporter of public services like the police forces whose numbers have been shredded by the Tories. Privatisation is driven by profit, and doesn't put public service first. A great example is the plan to remove guards from our trains.

The £4 billion Social Care cuts are putting the NHS under such strain that the service needs additional funding to meet the needs of our ageing population. Only Labour is committed to funding our NHS properly.

Schools in our area are having to make teachers redundant right now because of funding cuts per pupil. But the Tories want to waste money on Grammar schools for the few. Labour would invest in all our schools, not cut the spend per pupil.

East Yorkshire voted to leave the EU, but the question is what sort of Brexit will we get? Labour would put protecting jobs and workers rights first in the negotiations. The Tories aggressive approach will endanger our future prosperity. Don't give them a blank cheque on June 8th.
